Throughout the construction season, MaineDOT crews have the need to purchase hot asphalt, cold patch, and concrete products. Since these products must be placed within a limited amount of time, the location of the supplier's plant, in relation to the job site, is a determining factor in which plant(s) may be used. This request would establish master agreements with all vendors that are willing to provide a list of products and pricing for each plant location. The selected vendor for any project will be based upon the suitable product(s) available, haul time, and pricing.

Haul time is the most critical factor. Asphalt products must be above a certain temperature upon arriving on the job site for proper compaction and longevity. Concrete products must be placed before the concrete sets up in the truck.

We are receiving pricing and plant locations from all vendors and that information can be openly compared.


