A PLC in the Spruce Unit at Long Creek experienced water damage and needs to be repaired. Since the PLC is integrated into the security control system, it makes sense to include this segment of work in the current upgrade already in progress.

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

Johnson Controls Fire Protection has been under contract with the Department/Long Creek since February of 2023 to upgrade our Security Controls System. An amendment was done in May of last year to incorporate the lighting relays which are integrated with the Access Control software which enables staff to control lights from the day room screen or the control center. Additional time is needed to complete this task as well as to repair the damaged PLC in Spruce Unit as noted above.

3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

The cost is based on the vendor's proposal which appears consistent with previous work orders received by this vendor. Since the vendor is already on site, they were able to offer us discounted labor costs due to them already being mobilized on site which the Department considers fair and reasonable.

The Department is actively exploring competitive bid processes to obtain future Security System products and services.
