The Provider shall conduct direct technical assistance to the Department to support the refinement of a core framework in order to encapsulate the key learnings derived from the demonstration model. The Provider will provide site level consultation as needs are identified. In addition, the Provider will conduct technical assistance to develop a programming model as directed by Sec. 1 MRSA c. 1064 'An Act to Support Children's Healthy Development and School Success'. The Provider will orchestrate observation opportunities of Elevate Maine including site visit of existing settings from the demonstration model, provide reports or recommendations from program review, and connection with key stakeholders from demonstration model. The Provider will assist the Department in planning the First4ME installation and determining the sequence of implementation and key elements that should be prioritized.

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

KVCAP/Educare was the founder of the demonstration model of Elevate Maine, a unique rural childcare partnership to which First4ME was mirrored after. Several key components from LD1712 mirror the work done by KVCAP/Educare in this demonstration model. They have specific knowledge and consultation expertise to support the department's efforts to create a framework that is both progressive and needs responsive.

3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

Funding was allocated for a thirteen (13) -month technical assistance contract and consultation effort that mirrors the pilot window from current resources of a unique subset of knowledge and experiences related to the demonstration model, intellectual property, its entities and staff resources for weekly and on demand requests.

4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.

The pilot sites commenced August 2023 and conclude July 2026. KVCAP/Educare is the demonstration model for the First4ME pilot and will provide technical assistance for the duration of the pilot related to targeted consultation for pilot implementation. At the conclusion of the pilot window, the technical assistance and consultation from the demonstration model will no longer be a service needed by the Department.
