	The Tenable Security Center solution provides vulnerability scanning of the Department’s critical infrastructure including servers and end point assets containing privacy and election data. The solution produces reports that facilitate remediation of critical vulnerabilities and a gap in licensing and support increases risk of exposure of the Department’s information and systems to external threat actors.

	Presidio provides network and security services under the State’s master agreement MA - 2303090000000000106. The RQS BPO is submitted due to the service end date of the master agreement.

	The State of Maine has an existing Master Agreement with Presidio that includes licensing for security software and provides accurate, competitive pricing for the service.
