PART III: SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

Maine was awarded a Preschool Development Renewal Grant in December of 2022. One of the approved activities in this grant is a pilot of the First 10 Community School model with 7 schools across Maine. This approved activity includes an evaluation by an external evaluator. Originally, Maine was approved to share the evaluator for its state funded First4ME project with the First 10 Community School Pilot, but delays in executing the contract for the First4ME evaluator have necessitated securing a different evaluator for the First 10 Community School Pilot.

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

RMC Research Corporation is a nationally recognized company specializing in research and evaluation, technical assistance and consulting services, professional development, and product development in education and related fields. RMC has assisted leaders at the national, state, and local levels to learn and apply best practices to strengthen systems that lead to improved outcomes.

With over 40 years of experience, RMC staff have performed hundreds of studies that require varied research and evaluation designs and quantitative, qualitative, and mixed methods data collection. RMC staff have applied evaluation expertise to a variety of early childhood education research projects, including a focus on the alignment between pre-K and the early grades, training of elementary school principals in developmentally appropriate practice, comprehensive community services for vulnerable families and children, and professional development for early educators. Also applicable to this evaluation, RMC has considerable experience in Pre-K to Grade 3 continua development, having worked with several other states to design and evaluate tools for promoting these efforts.

RMC Research has also worked with Maine on its Preschool Development Initial Grant, conducting the needs assessment and strategic plan development, and is a subcontractor to Early Childhood Associates, the vendor conducting the evaluation for Maine's Preschool Development Renewal Grant. Working on these components of Maine's Preschool Development Grants has enabled RMC to gain strong understanding of the design of Maine's approved projects and their intended goals, including the First 10 Community School Project.

Finally, the amount of time remaining in the grant period necessitates securing an evaluator with knowledge of the model who can begin work expediently.

Costs negotiated with RMC Research are similar to those paid for its previous services for the State of Maine and will actually result in a cost savings from what was previously anticipated in the original plan of partnering with the First4ME evaluator.
