Trainers provide 48-hour blended learning course in-person training that will certify Maine State Park staff as Certified Interpretive Guides. Following the course staff will be able to demonstrate knowledge of the history of interpretation, basic principles of interpretation, program development and presentation. This training is a component of the Maine State Park Ranger Academy and will better prepare staff to tell the stories of our important landmarks and their related cultural and natural histories.

The National Association for Interpretation (NAI) is an internationally recognized non-profit training organization dedicated to advancing the profession of heritage interpretation. The CIG course that Maine State Park staff will be undertaking is the same course and certification used by the National Park Service to train and certify their interpretive rangers.
