PART III: SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

We are purchasing a stereo microscope with a digital camera for processing zooplankton samples. As part of habitat monitoring program, zooplankton samples will be collected throughout the Gulf of Maine and processed to the lowest possible taxonomic resolution. Zooplankton abundances and community composition are thought to be critical metrics in forecasting the presence of North Atlantic Right Whales. To identify key zooplankton down to species and life stage, a stereomicroscope with at least 60x is required. We also need a large base and working distance to manipulate our samples under the microscope. A microscope with a camera port and a color digital camera is required to train new taxonomists and document zooplankton species. Taxonomic data is

needed in the Gulf of Maine as we develop measures to reduce risk for the critically endangered NARW in a region that both supports foraging for whales and the American Lobster fishery, the most valuable single-species fishery in the U.S.

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

After obtaining multiple quotes from different stereo microscope vendors, Zeiss is the only vendor that makes a stereo microscope with the unique combination of a 1) high enough magnification (10-80x), 2) large enough working distance to manipulate the samples (69 mm), 3) large enough base to move the counting chamber without reaching the edge (working surface 255 x 215 mm), and a 4) camera mount. Zeiss' unique combination of specifications make it the best option for processing zooplankton samples. Additionally, the camera is not integrated into the microscope which allows us to upgrade or replace the camera in the future as camera technology continues to advance.

3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

The negotiated costs are fair and reasonable based on current market rates for equivalent technology. The SteREO Discovery V8 microscope has the highest magnification of all the stereo microscopes we were quoted and was on the lower end of the price range (\$10-17k). This microscope also allows for enhanced upgradability options should we need them in the future.

4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.

Procuring the SteREO Discovery V8 is a one-time purchase. Should we need to add an additional microscope to the lab, we will continue to explore other source options.
