When the court mandated that RPC address the issue of transient psychiatrists and the negative effect this was having on continuity of care for patients, Liberty Healthcare has responded to the needs of DDPC with high quality Nationally Board Certified full-time and long term part-time, medical staff.


**3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.**
