T37-1733 is a stainless-steel dump body. As part of the on-going deployment of new snowplow trucks, MaineDOT determined it would be more cost effective to refurbish and continue to use previously purchased truck bodies. Given the price volatility of new equipment, Fleet Services determined refurbishing would not only prolong the life of equipment already in place, but also provide the Department with a cost savings.

The Fleet Augusta Fab shop was too busy to take this task on. The vendor for this work was able to work it in and has trained technicians.

The labor and parts rates for the body refurbished are comparable to the other installation services currently under contract with his vendor. A cost proposal was provided to Fleet Services for review and approval was given for the work to be done.

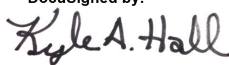

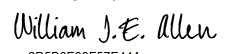
