


Wabanaki Public Health and Wellness shall use targeted investments to include, but are not limited to, efforts related to financial/IT improvements, data collection/reporting systems, operational infrastructure, strategic planning, and pilot projects and collective efforts to increase organizational effectiveness and address health disparities in their communities. As a result of these investments, the Department anticipates this Tribal Public Health District will have increased capacity to reduce racial/ethnic disparities in COVID-19 and other health conditions, as well as to continue providing COVID-19 prevention and response activities.

Wabanaki Public Health and Wellness is the Public Health Organization serving the tribes. Wabanaki Public Health and Wellness serves as the tribal public health district and is a trusted community resource for addressing health disparities in tribal communities.

The costs associated with these services have been reviewed by the Department for fairness and allowability. A portion of funding was set aside to support tribes and tribal public health organizations in addressing health disparities in their communities. Funding for Wabanaki Public Health and Wellness is comparable with awards given to other Health Equity Infrastructure providers and was reviewed by the department for the types of health equity services they will provide and the number and type of community engagement activities they will provide.
