The keynote we are looking to bring in would elevate the messaging and outcomes of the event and honor the caliber of work that has been poured into the MOOSE project to this point.

Amy Blankson, bestselling author of The Future of Happiness, is the only person to receive a Point of Light from two sitting US Presidents. After graduating from Harvard College and Yale School of Management, she has focused her work on understanding how to cultivate happiness in a digital era. She is a member of the UN Global Happiness Council, a Fellow of the World Innovation Organization, and is currently working with the IEEE to create standards for well-being in the creation of artificial intelligence and emotion awareness. Most recently, Amy has shared her thought leadership as a speaker at TEDx, as a regular contributor for Forbes on Women, Technology, and Leadership, and as a featured professor in Oprah's Happiness course. In the information economy, collaboration is the ultimate currency. Digital communities and platforms for knowledge sharing now enable us to "upsource" projects to collective wisdom, thereby tapping into vast reserves of knowledge and creativity. Yet at the heart of this movement are individuals, many of whom have ceased to believe that they can overcome systemic barriers to making a difference in their organization. The Ancient Greeks defined optimism as "the belief that our behavior matters," which is a critical concept for helping individuals to remove limiting beliefs and to shift towards solutions-based thinking.

Amy exemplifies the message we are trying to convey about educators as innovative agents of change in their communities. Amy understands the power of storytelling and will help to weave narrative into her presentation, helping educators see themselves in other individuals who have mobilized their communities for positive change. Her talk is action oriented and exemplifies the interdisciplinary, project based elements of MOOSE as she will use a combination of design thinking and experiential activities to help the educators experience how we can all be innovators if we act together with intention
