1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

There are two (2) distinct services provided in this service group, Crisis Intervention Mobile Response Services (Mobile Services) and Crisis Residential Services. The Provider shall provide effective Mobile Services and Residential services in the least restrictive setting and connect Persons in Crisis to community-based service providers.

This Contract is being amended to increase the Children's Ancillary funding to support increased utilization.

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the solicitation (RFP/RFA/RFQ) number if applicable.

These services were competitively bid under 201506114 (8 awards). Due to an appeal process under 201506114 for D1, 2, and 4, RFP 201706121 was issued. The award periods from 201506114 were adjusted as none of the contracts under any of the RFPs began until 4/1/2018.

In 2022, the Department began to restructure/reform its Crisis Services. The services delivered via the crisis continuum are safety net services for the citizens of Maine and service delivery cannot be interrupted. It is necessary to maintain current existing providers in their current roles to maintain stability and cause minimal disruption to the crisis continuum.

3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

Mobile and Crisis Residential rates are based on existing MaineCare rates. Based on utilization, providers are allocated ancillary funding based on costs that are outlined in the Rider A.

4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.

The Department has completed the competitive procurement process for both Mobile Crisis Intervention Response Services (RFP 202511151) and Crisis Residential Unit Services for Adults and Minors (202601002) with an anticipated new contract start date of 7/1/2026.

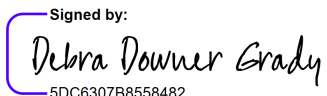

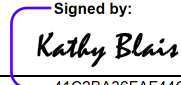
