1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

Mandatory Hazardous Waste Disposal from the DHHS Health & Environmental Testing Laboratory. Clean Harbor minimizes waste governed by RCRA regulations reducing the waste stream at Maine's Health and Environmental Testing Laboratory (HETL) through interpretation and providing guidance on waste management. The vendor conducts pick up services of hazardous waste in large quantities of greater than five gallons, which is needed at HETL. The hazardous waste disposal ranges from PCBs to cyanides. This vendor assists in the recycling of chemicals such as acetone, formamide, ketone, chloride, isopropyl alcohol, and methyl ethyl. This is to pay for an invoice (1004149981) for services that have been performed.

The vendor was chosen because they are located in Maine and can assist in a timely clean-up shall the lab need assistance in a spill of a chemical nature.


