PART III: SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

The purpose of this Contract is to support the Maine Open Habitat Raptor Project through the live-capture of Short-eared Owls, a state-threatened species, to enable GPS transmitter deployment. These services contribute directly to Objective 2 of the project: "Address knowledge gaps in the breeding ecology of American Kestrels, habitat and movement ecology of Short-eared Owls in Maine, and update ETSC data for tracked open habitat raptor species." The target population includes Short-eared Owls that use airports, grasslands, wetlands, and agricultural landscapes across Maine.

Short-eared Owls are experiencing widespread population declines, yet their full annual cycle movements and habitat associations remain poorly understood, particularly in Maine. The information collected through this project will help identify habitat needs, seasonal movement patterns, and potential threats during breeding and overwintering periods. This work is particularly relevant given increasing concerns about habitat loss from land conversion and changes in agricultural practices.

GPS tracking data will inform local, state, and regional conservation actions by improving our understanding of this species' ecology. These data will also support verifying and enhancing state records in the Maine Endangered, Threatened, and Special Concern (ETSC) database and developing an updated ETSC factsheet for the species

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

USDA Wildlife Services (WS) staff bring decades of experience in the live-capture of raptors, including more recent experience with Short-eared Owls. Their personnel possess the specialized skills and field expertise necessary to support this project. They have previously captured Short-eared Owls at the Portland Jetport, providing valuable pilot testing for the current effort.

This work requires advanced technical capacity in safe raptor handling, translocation, and release, which WS is uniquely qualified to provide. MDIFW does not hold the permits to conduct these captures independently, making this partnership essential.

The project builds on a long-standing collaborative relationship between WS and MDIFW and aligns with broader regional efforts to monitor and manage Short-eared Owls across the Atlantic Flyway. No other Maine-based organization offers the same combination of raptor-specific field proficiency, permitting, and infrastructure. Given these qualifications, WS is the only provider capable of delivering the required services within the project's scope and timeframe.

3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

The cost and rate proposed by USDA Wildlife Services (WS) are based on their extensive experience conducting live capture of raptors in Maine. These rates are consistent with industry standards for fieldwork requiring technical expertise, specialized equipment, and compliance with animal welfare and permitting requirements. Their familiarity with similar field protocols ensures cost efficiency and high success rates, making the negotiated rate fair and appropriate for this work.

4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.

This collaborative effort is uniquely suited to USDA WS due to their demonstrated expertise in safely and efficiently capturing Short-eared Owls and other sensitive bird species in Maine. Their existing infrastructure, trained personnel, and successful track record with raptor capture and handling provide critical capacity not readily available through other vendors. Given the specialized nature of the work and the strong existing partnership with MDIFW, future competition is not anticipated unless project needs or staffing circumstances change.
