Short Description of Good or Service:	Build up to 50 prototypes of the newest version of the Time Tension Line Cutter (TTL) for field testing with select fishermen. Additional funding was obtained through the federal Bycatch Reduction Engineering Program to expand this project in length and increase the number of units to be made and field tested. The TTL is a device that can be used as a gear modification on vertical lines in the lobster fishery to release endangered large whales in the event of an entanglement in the line.

2. Description of Specific Need

Please identify, and fully describe, the specific problem, requirement, or need the resulting non- competitive contract would address and which makes the goods or services necessary. Explain how the requesting Department determined that the goods or services are critical and/or essential to agency responsibilities or operations.

The Department of Marine Resources (DMR) is currently working with the federal Atlantic Large Whale Take Reduction Team (TRT) on behalf of the State of Maine to reduce the risk of entanglement of right whales in fixed fishing gear. Maine DMR is currently scoping regulatory changes and modifications to gear that will reduce the risk of entanglements and provide the fishery with safe and efficient options. Currently, one of the primary techniques being discussed to achieve this is fishing a weaker vertical line. However, there are significant safety concerns over this technique in parts of the fishery that fish heavier sets of gear. The Time Tension Line Cutter is the only concept that enables the fisherman to maintain the hauling strength of his/her line when needed, but will actively cut the line and release a whale that has been entangled. This is achieved by setting a load that a whale will exert on a line over a time that is longer than it takes a fisherman to haul his/her gear. Blue Water Concepts developed this technology and has proven that the concept works. Blue Water Concepts is the only company building this technology. They have been working to refine the design to make it more operationally feasible for fishermen. DMR received federally grant money through the Bycatch Reduction Engineering Program, in which Blue Water Concepts is a Co-investigator. The grant tasks Blue Water Concepts with building 50 prototypes of the new design so that they may be field tested with fishermen in the fall, winter, and spring of 2019 and 2020. DMR is interested in putting this technology on a list of approved methods for fishing safer vertical lines. This will provide more flexibility for Maine fixed gear fishermen in the federal regulations to protect endangered right whales.

3. Availability of other Public Resources

No state, local, or federal agency has the expertise to design and build the Time Tension Line Cutter. Blue Water Concepts is the Maine based engineering company that pioneered this idea and has done the initial prototype building and testing. DMR is working with Blue Water Concepts to refine the technology, field test it, and get it into the federal regulations as an option for Maine fishermen to use.

4. Cost

DMR has worked with Blue Water Concepts to develop the budget for building prototypes and field testing the technology. DMR worked with Blue Water Concepts and some other project partners to apply for and received federal grant funds through the Bycatch Reduction Engineering Program to alleviate state funds needed to support this work.

This technology was developed by Blue Water Concepts and they are the only group or company that is designing and building these devices.

Blue Water Concepts developed, built, and tested the initial design of the Time Tension Line Cutter in the early 2000's. They have taken the initial feedback from these tests and recently designed a more operationally friendly prototype. They are the only engineering company that is suited to use their designs, testing data, facilities, and expertise to perfect this technology, build more prototypes, and get them out in the field for testing with fishermen. This is not a product that is available on the market.
