<p>The REMI PI + economic model is an economic impact analysis modeling software. The purchase of this software allows the Commissioner's Office to produce analyses of the impact on the state's economy of different economic, demographic, and policy changes. The office previously purchased the model; this is the licensing agreement for the next calendar year.</p>

#### 2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II.

The input-output economic analysis model is proprietary to Regional Economic Models Inc. There are only two primary companies in the US in this marketplace as general purpose economic impact analysis modeling software is a highly specialized field. There are several elements of Regional Economic Models, Inc's product that make it better suited to our needs, including more extensive time series data, the ability to do cost benefit analysis and in model forecasting and the availability of an add-on fiscal analysis module.

#### 3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

The annual maintenance cost has been unchanged since the model was brought back up to date in 2016.

#### 4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.

There are very few companies in the US that produce this type of economic impact analysis software as it is a highly specialized field. If there is additional demand in the national marketplace, other companies might develop similar software packages in the future.
