### PART III: SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

The Federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) requires local educational agencies (LEAs/SAUs) to provide an annual assessment of English language proficiency for all students with limited English proficiency in schools served by the State educational agency (SEA).

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

Maine has maintained membership within the WIDA consortium and utilized the ACCESS for ELLS® assessment to meet the Federal requirements under Title III of the ESEA since 2003. The Maine DOE as a WIDA Consortium Member approves and/or purchases the Core Package of WIDA Consortium educational services. This aids the state in:

- satisfying the state and local educational agency requirements of Title I and Title III of the ESEA;
- building and enhancing Maine DOE's capacity to assist English Learners obtain academic standards and English language proficiency
- determine annual growth towards and attainment of English language proficiency to meet accountability requirements.

Changing to another vendor would incur additional costs for an external contractor to perform an independent alignment and crosswalk study in addition to any further costs regarding the implementation of the assessment in general and subsequent training for assessment administrators.

3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.

Maine completed a cost analysis of membership to the WIDA consortium in 2002 and has reviewed this analysis in recent years to ensure the costs are fair and reasonable with other known and accepted computer based English language proficiency assessments. Additionally, the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs ® assessment is aligned to Maine's English language development standards and correspond to Maine's academic standards.

4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.

Maine is one of thirty-six (36) member states within the WIDA Consortium. A current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is in effect through the 2023 assessment administration cycle. Participation in the WIDA consortium continues to provide the greatest cost benefit to Maine at this time. Maine will continue to complete periodic cost analyses of other English language proficiency assessments that are aligned with Maine's English language development standards and ensures compliance with all federal regulations under Titles I and III.
