The Maine Department of Education is partnering with the Maine Department of Health and Human Services of a federally awarded Preschool Development Grant (PDG). One of the approved projects in the PDG is supporting the transition into kindergarten. Transitioning into Kindergarten is a very exciting but often overwhelming time for young learners and their families. Building strong transition plans that include community partnerships enables schools and educators to be ready to meet children and families where they are in many aspects of this transition period. Representatives from all SAUs and community early care and education providers were encouraged to register for the Kindergarten Transition technical assistance (TA) program. Participants engaged in a TA program that guided the strengthening of community partnerships, equitable practices for families, and a universal understanding of what it means to be ready for children and families to succeed in kindergarten. The goal of implementing kindergarten transition plans is to increase family engagement, encourage school attendance, and build strong partnerships to support kindergarten transitions for children, families, and school communities.

2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.

Participants who engaged in the entire TA program with the Maine DOE, formed a transition team, and developed a year-long transition plan to support children and families before, during, and after the transition to kindergarten were eligible to apply for a mini-grants to support the implementation of the plans leading up to and continue into the 2025-2026 school year. All participants who submitted a Kindergarten Transition application were granted a mini-grant.

The costs associated with supporting the Kindergarten Transition Plans were negotiated as part of the application process for each applicant.
