## Award Justification Statement RFP# 202206097 – Forensic Toxicology Services

## I. Summary

The Maine Office of Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) provides forensic pathology death investigation services for the entire State of Maine. The OCME will require over 1,400 forensic toxicology specimen analyses of some type over the course of a year. Toxicology screening and confirmation is required for alcohol, illicit and prescription substances, and carbon monoxide. Specialized analysis for less common substances or analysis using tissue or decomposed specimens are required. The OCME is seeking forensic toxicology services. There were two bids received, and NMS Labs was selected.

### II. Evaluation Process

The evaluation team consisted of Lindsey Chasteen, OCME Office Administrator, Erik Hyatt, OCME Director of Lab & Mortuary Services, and Mark Toulouse, Office of the Attorney General, Director of Finance/Chief of Administrative Division. Each team member read each bid and completed their individual evaluation notes. The evaluation team applied the consensus method in scoring the bidders qualifications, experience, and proposed services. Scores for the cost proposal were assigned using a mathematical formula.
