Award Justification Statement RFP# 202312254 Housing Opportunity Program Municipal Grants

I. Summary

The State of Maine, Department of Economic and Community Development (Department) sought applications for municipal grants. Municipal grants are grants to municipalities for community housing planning and implementation services to support the creation of housing development plans, including municipal ordinances, and policy amendments to support those plans. Municipality was defined as a city or a town, excluding all unorganized and deorganized townships, plantations, townships, and towns that have delegated administration of land use controls to the Maine Land Use Planning Commission pursuant to <u>12 M.R.S. § 682(1)</u>. Twenty-five applications were timely received, and upon recommendation of the evaluation team, the Department approved funding all but four applicants, conditioned upon final approval by the State Procurement Review Committee and the successful negotiation of contracts.

II. Evaluation Process

The evaluation process began with an individual review of each application by each of the reviewers, followed by consensus scoring by the group of reviewers. The reviewers rated each proposal according to the scoring guidelines outlined in the RFA. Reviewers were staff members from the Maine Department of Economic and Community Development.

Each staff member has expertise in land use planning, housing policy, and working with municipal governments on housing and community development initiatives.

III. Qualifications & Experience

All applicants were required to demonstrate capacity, expertise and previous experience in community planning services, housing policy, and ordinance development. All applicants sufficiently demonstrated the experience and capacity necessary to carry out the proposed projects and yielded scores in the range that allowed for funding

IV. Proposed Services

Grantees will implement projects related to ordinance development and community housing planning services, as outlined in the RFA.

V. Cost Proposal

Municipalities were eligible for an award of up to \$50,000 for a grant serving one municipality and up to \$175,000 for grants serving two or more municipalities.
