Consulting Services to Review Available Grid Enhancing Technologies to Reduce or Defer Need for Investment in Grid Infrastructure

I. Summary

The RFP was issued on behalf of the Maine PUC seeking proposals for expert consulting services to conduct a review of available GETs that could be implemented by large investor-owned transmission and distribution utilities (IOU) to reduce or defer the need for investment in grid infrastructure in the State

II. Evaluation Process

The evaluation process was conducted in accordance with the rules and protocols of the State of Maine. Specifically, a team consensus approach was used to assign scores for Sections II and III, and Section IV was scored using the required mathematical formula. The evaluation team included three PUC Staff members, each of whom has extensive experience in the areas relevant to this project. Individuals on the team included a senior analyst, an analyst, and a staff attorney.

III. Qualifications & Experience

The proposal of the awarded bidder indicated extensive on-point experience and strong qualifications related to the subject matter areas and processes relevant to this project. The awarded bidder has presented a highly experienced team that has demonstrated expertise in performing relevant projects.

IV. Proposed Services

The proposal of the awarded bidder provided detailed and comprehensive descriptions of the scope of the services to be provided as well as a thorough and logical process that covered all steps in the process and indicated a clear understanding of the key objectives of this analysis. The selection committee indicated that the awarded bidder has a deep understanding of the New England and Maine electric system, transmission planning and cost benefit analysis.

V. Cost Proposal

Cost proposal of the awarded bidder: \$125,550.

The winning bidder offered an optional enhanced study which would include stakeholder interviews and a written report instead of the proposed final power-point presentation. The bid was evaluated on the base scope of work.

VI. Conclusion

For the reasons summarized above, the consensus evaluation and scoring of the evaluation team resulted in the award to E3 as indicated in the accompanying evaluation and scoring documents.
