Award Justification Statement RFP# 202408154 Consultant for FERC Transmission Rate Analysis

I. Summary

The RFP was issued on behalf of the Maine PUC seeking proposals for expert consulting services to review the annual informational FERC filings.

II. Evaluation Process

The evaluation process was conducted in accordance with the rules and protocols of the State of Maine. Specifically, a team consensus approach was used to assign scores for Sections II and III, and Section IV was scored using the required mathematical formula. The evaluation team included three PUC Staff members, each of whom has extensive experience in the areas relevant to this project. Individuals on the team included a senior analyst, an analyst, and a staff attorney.

III. Qualifications & Experience

The proposal of the awarded bidder indicated extensive on-point experience and strong qualifications related to the subject matter areas and processes relevant to this project. The awarded bidder has presented a highly experienced team that has demonstrated significant subject matter expertise in performing relevant projects.

IV. Proposed Services

The proposal of the awarded bidder provided detailed and comprehensive descriptions of the scope of the services to be provided as well as a thorough and logical process that covered all steps in the process and indicated a clear understanding of the key objectives of this analysis. The selection committee indicated that the awarded bidder has a deep understanding of the FERC formula rate process.

V. Cost Proposal

Cost proposal of the awarded bidder: \$271,000

Appendix D of the RFP provides: "Should an adjudicatory proceeding commence, the Commission will use the consultant's hourly rates from any resulting contract and the work will be conducted on a time and materials basis." Based on that, it is unclear whether "formal" challenges before FERC (identified as within the scope of the RFP) would be part of an adjudication (and thus outside of the scope of the RFP), and also unclear whether "other project

costs" for this RFP should include costs associated with travel to FERC--which would be a formal adjudication. The winning bidder provided pricing for both the base bid as well as additional costs for formal challenge. For this evaluation we used the higher of the two, \$271,000 In other words, under either treatment of the costs associated with formal challenges, the bid from GDS receives the highest total score.

VI. Conclusion

For the reasons summarized above, the consensus evaluation and scoring of the evaluation team resulted in the award to GDS Associates as indicated in the accompanying evaluation and scoring documents.
