Award Justification Statement RFP# 202410180-Purchase of Landing Craft Style Watercraft for Maine State Parks and the Allagash Wilderness Waterway

- I. Summary: The State of Maine, Department of Agriculture, Conservation, and Forestry is seeking proposals for four landing craft style watercraft to be used on both open ocean and inland bodies of water. These watercraft must meet required specifications to effect in-water rescue operations, onshore landing of equipment, materials, and personnel.
- II. Evaluation Process: The evaluation team evaluated two proposals submitted for RFP # 202410180. Each team member evaluated both proposals individually, taking notes on each proposal and submitting the notes to the RFP coordinator. No scoring was done during the individual evaluations. Once all individual evaluation notes were received by the RFP coordinator, Ronald Shaw, a team consensus meeting was held. Both proposals were reviewed and scored at this time. Scoring consisted of the following criteria: one Pass/Fail section and three numerical sections as outlined in Part V, section B of the RFP. The three numerical sections had a total of 100 points available. The evaluation team consisted of the following individuals:
 - Ron Hunt: Subject matter expert
 - Mark Deroche: Business/Subject matter expert
 - Janet Johnson: Financial Expert

III. Qualifications & Experience

- Lyman Morse provided a much more detailed overview of the organization and fabrication facility.
- Lyman Morse provided a detailed organizational chart listing all possible employees that may be engaged in building the landing craft boats. Munson provided information on only the top three personnel in the company.
- Lyman Morse has 150 employees, including 20 certified in-house fabricators.
- The Lyman Morse welding program is certified by AWS, ABS, ASME, and NAVSEA.
- Lyman Morse has three in-house American Welding Society Certified Welding Inspectors.
- Lyman Morse provided detailed information on the one subcontractor that will be used on this project.
- Lyman Morse has been building boats for 46 years, Munson approximately 40.
- Lyman Morse is currently engaged in a 52-vessel order for the US Navy and has seven aluminum work boats under construction and appear to have the capacity to construct the boats for the State of Maine.

 Multiple pictures of relevant boats produced by Lyman Morse were included in addition to the requested three references. Munson only provided the three references requested.

IV. Proposed Services

- Construction of one 21' & three 23' welded aluminum catamaran landing craft as described in the RFQ.
- The proposals from both companies meet all minimum specifications.
- Lyman Morse intends to use aluminum in certain areas of the boats that exceeds expectations.
- Lyman Morse provided a 22-page proposed services implementation plan
 which included an outline, preliminary drawings, and a 13-page section
 outlining the methods, resources and achievement of outcomes for all aspects
 of the boat building project. Munson provided the specifications for the boat(s).
- The Lyman Morse proposal followed the RFP step by step and provided all requested information in a very detailed manner.
- The Munson proposal provided the minimum amount of information necessary to submit the RFP.

VI. Conclusion

• Lyman Morse Boatbuilding submitted the most detailed and comprehensive proposal, followed the RFP step by step, and outlined their qualifications very well. The level of detailed presented in their proposal is impressive and we have confidence that they can supply the requested boats.
