1. Technical Assessment

- a. Maine IT's Technical Assessment Consensus Team determined that the Bidder has not demonstrated the capability to meet the stated requirements and policies at a base level.
- b. Bidder consistently provided responses for all RFP elements but did not provide quality evidence to demonstrate their capabilities.
- c. Bidder does not currently hold SOC 2 Type II certification and would need to be certified to meet Compliance requirements of the RFP. Bidder notes recent CMMI and ISO certifications that indicate SOC 2 Type II could likely be attained.
- d. If Bidder is preferred, Maine IT would need to see additional details outlining how Bidder would sufficiently meet Technical Requirements through documented plans, policies, and procedures.

2. Services to be Provided

- a. *Hosting* Bidder states they will use AWS for hosting and currently provides hosting services for seven different government systems.
- b. *Design audit* Bidder provides a detailed description of the tools used for a Design Audit that would lead to understanding of the system, identification of any compliance issues, and present areas for suggested enhancements.
- c. Technical audit Bidder provides detailed description of tools and process for a Technical Audit that would lead to understanding the system, establishing a security and accessibility baseline, and provide areas for suggested enhancements.
- d. Maintenance & Support Bidder outlines maintenance and monitoring, including operations and maintenance specific tools.
 - i. Corrective & Knowledge support Bidder uses JIRA to track work tickets for corrective management and as a reference for ongoing maintenance and improvement. JIRA tracking will also be used to create a forward looking roadmap for long-term features and deliverables.

- f. Reporting Bidder's basic reporting includes uptime/downtime statistics, service/ticket reports, and reports related to Agile project management.
- g. Staffing The Bidder has identified a team that meets current RFP requirements and demonstrated commitment to a 'continuous improvement' environment where they will proactively suggest enhancements.
- h. Project Management
 - Methodology The Bidder utilizes Agile methodologies (including Kanban and Scrum) and suggests tailoring those methodologies as needed to meet project needs
 - ii. Manager Bidder provides an experienced Project Manager with PMP certification.
 - iii. Management Bidder acknowledges the need for a Change Management process and is willing to follow existing State processes or co-create a process to ensure alignment. Bidder will move forward with work after approval from the State.
 - iv. Workplan The Bidder integrates additional client accessible project management software (SmartSheet) with JIRA to help ensure transparency and clear communication. Workplans would be used/reviewed within weekly/bi-weekly meetings with the State to review progress and align on next steps.
- i. Quality Assurance and Acceptance Bidders testing process is not well documented or detailed and the elements of proposed testing environments are not clear even though Development, User Acceptance Testing and Production environments are named. Bidder does commit to receiving final approval from the State before moving forward with any updates.
