1. Purpose

Through the subject RFP, the Department sought an Implementation Reviewer to evaluate and report on data related to Statewide practices concerning oversight of the administration of Psychotropic Medications to children and youth in the Department's custody.

2. Evaluation Process

An evaluation team was composed of four evaluators from the Department of Health and Human Services. The evaluation team performed individual evaluations of each proposal and recorded individual notes, then met as a team to apply the consensus method for recording the team notes and assigning scores to each proposal for Qualifications and Experience and the Proposed Services sections. Cost was scored using a mathematical formula.

3. Conditional Awards

As a result of the evaluation process, the evaluation team announced its conditional contract award to the following vendor:

4. Qualifications & Experience

The Conditional Awardee provided a well-rounded response outlining an understanding of, and ability to meet, programmatic requirements of the RFP. Additionally, the Conditional Awardee demonstrated the means and skills necessary to meet the RFP's performance requirements through their project teams' competencies, subject matter expertise, and background.

6. Cost Proposal

Clarus Research submitted a cost of \$899,550.00 and was the lowest cost proposed.

7. Conclusion

Out of 100 possible points, the evaluation team awarded Clarus Research a total score of 82.00. The strength of the awarded proposal outweighed the other proposals through a combination of its qualifications and experience, proposed services, and proposed cost. The evaluation team determined that the proposal submitted by Clarus Research represents the best value to the State of Maine.
