BIDDER QUESTIONS

Notice is hereby given that Addendum #3 provides clarification for questions asked by Bidders received via email.

- 1. Q: Please supply a striping plan for alternate 4 so bidders are looking/bidding the same thing. How is alternate 4 going to be implemented if alternates 1 though 3 are not done in their entirety?
 - A: Bidders should prepare a paint striping estimate for bid alternate 4 for approximately 4,000 linear feet for 4-inch white paint lines. Bid alternate 4 will not be executed if bid alternates 1 through 3 are not constructed.
- 2. Q: Please clarify with BGS that 1.5" of total pavement thickness shall be acceptable over areas that the mill breaks through to existing gravel
 - A: In areas where, during the milling process, there isn't at least 1.5 inches of existing pavement and the milling machine breaks through, the contractor is to place 1.5 inches of pavement consistent with the Pavement Mill and Overlay Section detail in the plan set.
