  - a. Materials testing and Third Party Special Inspections will be handled under a separate Owners contract. All other testing noted throughout drawings and specifications not included in the Table below are to be provided by the Contractor and covered in the contract price. Coordination and scheduling of testing under Owner's contract is the responsibility of the Contractor.

- 5. Question: Notice to contractors says filed sub bids are not required. The Bid Form shows that filed sub bids are required. Please confirm which is correct.
  - a. Filed sub bids are **not** required.
- 6. On drawing AE660, there is a room signage schedule showing a specific amount ADA signs. Is that all we do or is there, or will there, be more as seen in drawing G-109 (phasing plans)?
  - a. Signage noted on both G-109 and AE660 is to be provided by the contractor. The signage on G-109 is for during construction only and is temporary. Language for temporary signage is to be coordinated with Owner and Authority Having Jurisdiction prior to installation.
- 7. AE660 mentions "(A) REINSTALL SALVAGED ROOM SIGNAGE". How many will be reinstalled?
  - a. As noted on Room Signage Schedule and Signage Schedule Notes, Note A applies to existing signage 110/112 only.
