

NOTICE TO ARCHITECTS AND ENGINEERS
REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Department of Agriculture, Conservation, and Forestry, Bureau of Parks and Lands wishes to procure architectural/engineering services for the Sandy **River Bridge and Trail** (BGS 3681) to extend the Whistle Stop Multi-Use Trail from West Farmington to **downtown Farmington, Maine.** Federal NEPA application required. Qualifications packages are due at 1:00 p.m. on **April 12th, 2024**, as stated in the RFQ.

This project is to build a multi-use bridge over the Sandy River and trails to connect downtown Farmington to the Whistle Stop Trail.
