

NOTICE TO ARCHITECTS AND ENGINEERS  
REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Maine Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management wishes to procure architectural/engineering services for the Repair Base-wide Pavements project at the Maine Air National Guard Base in Bangor, Maine. Qualifications packages are due at 1:00 p.m. on **24 July 2025**, as stated in the RFQ.

The Maine Air National Guard intends to repair various sidewalk, parking lot, and roadway pavements on the Bangor Air National Guard Base as well as pave the base running track with an alternate bid item to add a rubberized coating to the track pavements. The project site is located within a military controlled access installation. The scope of services for this project includes, but may not be limited to, schedule and cost estimating, preliminary design, design development, contract documents, and administration of bidding and construction. The AE Consultant may be required to coordinate this work or additional work with other consultants contracted by the Owner.
