NOTICE TO ARCHITECTS AND ENGINEERS
REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ)

The Maine Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services, wishes to procure engineering services to conduct a study reviewing statewide waste disposal capacity. The study will evaluate traditional as well as new and innovative technologies to support waste infrastructure development including recycling components and renewable energy generation. Qualifications packages are due at 1:00 p.m. on August 14, 2026, as stated in the RFQ.

The scope of services for this study includes evaluating the data and information from solid waste management reports to anticipate future gaps in solid waste disposal capacity within the State of Maine. Scope of services also includes a review of volume reducing technologies to recommend the most appropriate and beneficial technologies to be constructed at new solid waste disposal facility to be paired with landfill capacity. Infrastructure will be utilized to reduce the amount of solid waste being sent to a future State-owned landfill to preserve the life of the landfill to the most extent practicable.
