






Population by Region




Components of Population Change in Maine, 2021 Rate per thousand population




Percent of Households Unable to Afford Median Home, 2021

Share of 2020 Population by Race/Ethnicity




Maine has the oldest population... ...by median age (44.7 years) ...and by % of population age 65+ (21.7%)

The Baby Boom: 1946-1964




Health Insurance Coverage of the Population, 2021


Maine Civilian Labor Force




In the Annual Workforce Report for 2021, the Maine Department of Labor notes:

- The rising share of retired population is the primary factor in lower participation in the state.
- A higher share of retirement age population is the reason total labor force participation is lower in Maine than the nation.

Maine's unemployment rate in November 2022 is above prepandemic levels but well below the long-run average unemployment







Share of Maine Nonfarm Employment by Industry




Most sectors in November 2022 were near or above November 2019 levels, the exceptions being:



<u>Wages</u>: how will wage expectations adjust to inflation and the tight labor market?


The Great Reshuffle: how does the search for "better" work pan out in the long run?

<u>Self-employment</u>: are more workers choosing self-employment and gig work?


<u>Automation</u>: will employers who struggle to find workers substitute with technology?


Quarterly Real GDP (in millions of chained 2012 dollars)

Wages have increased sharply over the past two years, but higher inflation has flattened out recent gains















Federal supports including stimulus payments and Child Tax Credit played a role in reducing poverty in 2021


National Supplemental Poverty Measure (SPM) = 7.8%, 1.4 percentage points lower than 2020 and the lowest rate since the measure was first published

The SPM child poverty rate fell 46% in 2021, from 9.7% to 5.2%, the lowest rate on record


Social Security is the most significant antipoverty program, moving 26.3 million people nationally out of poverty as measured by the SPM

In Maine, the 3-year average SPM for 2019-2021 was 5.4%, 3.8 percentage points below the official poverty rate of 9.2% and the second-lowest in the nation along with Wisconsin


Median Household Income




Year-over-year percent change in Consumer Price Index



Year-over-year percent change in Consumer Price Index; 2001-2022 historical and 2022-2027 forecast




Most of the Budget Goes Toward Defense, Social Security, and Major Health Programs





