Subject: Guidance to Clarify Existing Requirements for Different Adult Use Cannabis &

Cannabis Product Sample Types

Background

This guidance is provided by the Office of Cannabis Policy (OCP) to remind adult use licensees of the different requirements and processes applicable to consumer samples, employee samples, trade samples, and research and development (R&D) samples. This is in light of multiple, unrelated instances of samples being recorded incorrectly in the inventory tracking system.

Guidance

There are four (4) types of samples authorized in the Adult Use Cannabis Program, each with distinct differences in the amount allowable, who can receive them, and how they are tracked. This does not include samples for mandatory testing, which are separate and distinct from the samples outlined here.

- Consumer Sample: Provided by a cannabis store to a consumer who is at least 21 years of age for no remuneration.
- **Employee Sample:** Provided by a cannabis establishment to its employees for the purposes of employee education.
- **Trade Sample:** Provided by a cultivation or manufacturing facility to another Maine adult use cannabis licensee for business or marketing purposes only.
- **R&D Sample:** Provided to a testing facility by a cannabis establishment for testing for research and development purposes only.

The approved products, product quantities, distribution limits, inventory tracking system workflows, and other requirements vary by sample type. Adult use licensees can refer to the chart accompanying this guidance document for information regarding the specific requirements for each sample type. For instructions on how to properly record different sample types in Metrc, the State's inventory tracking system, licensees should refer to the Metrc Support bulletin entitled, "Sample Types in Metrc" distributed on May 29, 2025, and available here.
