## Subject: Notice of Revocation of Registry Identification Card

Dear Kevin,

The Maine Department of Administrative & Financial Services, Office of Cannabis Policy (the Department) is responsible for the administration and oversight of the Maine Medical Use of Cannabis Program (MMCP). The Department hereby revokes the following Registry Identification Card: **KEVIN PAUL GLAUDE**, **RIC18445**. This is a statutorily required revocation pursuant to 19-A M.R.S. § 2201 because the Department of Health and Human Services has certified that you are a support obligor who is not in compliance with an order of support. This revocation is effective three (3) calendar days after the date of this notice.

## Justification for revocation:

The Department's decision to revoke your Registry Identification Card is based the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Support Enforcement and Recovery, certificate dated 03/11/2024, to revoke your Medical Cannabis credentials. This certificate requires that Office of Cannabis Policy to revoke your Medical Cannabis credentials as you have not met the terms of a legal Child Support Order. This revocation will stay in effect until the Department of Health and Human Services issues a Statement of Compliance indicating that you have complied with Maine law regarding child support, or are currently considered exempt from enforcement.

For these reasons, your authorization to participate in the MMCP has been revoked. Please immediately return your Registry Identification Card to:

## **Registration Revocation and Right to Judicial Review:**
