Dear Registered Maine Medical Marijuana Program Participant:

As you may be aware, the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Act was revised effective December 13, 2018. Included in these revisions was the removal of the cap of 5 patients per caregiver. As a result of this change, our program will now be issuing one card per caregiver to reduce confusion and to improve efficiency within our office. The new card will be issued at the time of your next caregiver registration renewal. If there are different dates on your cards, the issue and expiration date will be pro-rated. The card will be changed to Registered Caregiver (CGR) and will have the following *additional* information:

Registered caregiver
DBA: Retail/storefront name if applicable
Retail location if applicable
Authorized for: re: 6 Mature/12 Immature and/or Harvested

The Maine Medical Marijuana Program, Office of Marijuana Policy, believes this change is an improvement across the board for all participants.
