COMMODITY ITEM: Pheasants - Adult

CONTRACT PERIOD: Through August 31, 2019. The State of Maine with vendor approval can opt to issue up to two (2) one (1) year extensions.

VENDOR CONTACT PERSON: The contact person will help consumers place orders, inquire about orders that have not been delivered, all shipping issues, quality issues, and any issues pertaining to this Master Agreement. EXTENSION OF CONTRACT: The Director of Procurement Services may, with the consent of the contractor extend the Contract period beyond the indicated expiration date.

CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT: The Division of Procurement Services reserves the right to cancel a contract with a thirty-day written notice OR cancel immediately if the contractor does not conform to terms and conditions and specifications of contract.

PRICES: Prices shown are to be net including transportation charges fully pre-paid by the contractor FOB destination.

QUANTITIES: It is understood and agreed that the contract will cover the **actual quantities** required by State Agency over the length of the contract.

ORDERING PROCEDURE: Delivery orders (DO) will be created in AdvantageME for all orders over \$5000.00. If a DO is used, the DO will be e-mailed to the email address set up in AdvantageME by the Vendor as a .pdf file. Orders less than \$5000.00 can be ordered using a P-Card.

DELIVERY: The Contractor will be responsible for the delivery of material in first class condition at the point of delivery, and in accordance with good commercial practice. See other Delivery specifications below.

QUARTERLY REPORT: The Division of Procurement Services **requires a quarterly report of sales** be faxed to 207-287-6578 within 30 days of the end of each calendar quarter. It will be the responsibility of the vendor to produce a quarterly report. The report must include the dollar value of goods purchased, broken down by Department as well as the total dollar value of purchases made by all Departments.

PROCUREMENT CARD: State policy requires vendors to accept the State of Maine Procurement Card (P-Card) as a form of payment, with very rare exceptions. Your company will be required to accept these cards. The pricing offered to the State of Maine shall be the final cost to the State of Maine regardless of payment method. No surcharge or other compensation will be allowed. The State of Maine reserves the right to reject your bid if you are unwilling to accept this condition.

Specifications

State of Maine Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife, in coordination with several local fish and game clubs, plan to order between +/- 2,000 and 2,300 adult ring-necked pheasant meeting the criteria outlined, below. These birds are being acquired to fulfill the needs of the state's public hunting season on pheasant. The required specifications include:

Physical / Health

- A statement from a veterinarian, from the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, or from the conservation department of the state from which the pheasants are imported certifying that they are from flocks that have tested negative for pullorum and typhoid and show no evidence of WNV, tuberculosis, other infectious and contagious disease and unreasonable fecal parasite load for a period of 6 months prior to delivery. It is also required to submit a record of all medicines and vaccines administered to birds. Written documentation of above must be provided prior to delivery.
- It is preferred that all birds be from a single source.
- All birds must be fully feathered and tail feathers must average at least 8" in length.
- Sex ratio must comprise at least 50% males.
- All birds must be strong flyers.
- All dead/injured/missing birds must be replaced by provider, at no additional cost, prior to final release of season.
- Males are not to weigh less than 2.5 lbs., while females are not to weigh less than 2.0 lbs.
- Transport crates must be new or properly disinfected since last being occupied by birds.
- Intact beaks are much preferred, though if clipped, the difference between the upper and lower mandible must not exceed 3/16".
- It is preferred that birds not be tagged or marked in any way upon delivery.
- MDIFW staff reserves the right to reject any birds not meeting the above criteria.
- MDIFW staff reserves the right to inspect the provider's facility.

Delivery

- Delivery will be made at two locations on the agreed upon delivery days. The first delivery location is the public lot at the Wells Transportation Facility/Amtrak Station, located just off The Maine Turnpike at Exit 19. The second delivery location is the parking lot at the Cabelas retail store on Payne Rd. in Scarborough.
- The first delivery of at least 700 birds must be made prior to October 1.
- The timing of subsequent stockings is negotiable, but October 4 and 18 is preferred.
- Deliveries are to be made in the morning, preferably before 9:00 a.m
