Contract Terms and Conditions

"Diagnostic Reagents and Tests"

SCOPE: To furnish the normal requirement to cover the quantities for all using agencies for "Diagnostic Reagents and Tests" during a period of one year.

CONTRACT PERIOD: Contract to be for a period of one year beginning with the date of award. The State of Maine reserves the right, with the consent of the contractor, to renew any contract issued for additional terms in one year increments.

ESTIMATED VALUE: The yearly value of this contract is approximately \$200,000. It is understood and agreed, however, that the contract shall cover all the quantities ordered by state agencies during the term of the contract, whether more or less than the amount indicated.

PRICES & DISCOUNTS: Prices will remain firm for the duration of the contract. Prices include all transportation charges F.O.B. Destination.

ORDERING PROCEDURE: Delivery Orders (DO) will be created in AdvantageME for all orders against Master Agreements (MA), unless the State of Maine Procurement Card is used for payment. Orders in the amount of \$5,000.00 or less will be e-mailed by the using agency to the Vendor as a .pdf file. Delivery Orders in amounts greater than \$5,000.00 will workflow to the Division of Purchases' Buyers for approval and encumbrance. The Division of Purchases will e-mail the .pdf order to the Vendor.

PROCUREMENT CARD: State policy requires vendors to accept the State of Maine Procurement Card as a form of payment, with very rare exceptions. Your company will be required to accept these cards. The pricing offered to the State of Maine shall be the final cost to the State of Maine regardless of payment method. No surcharge or other compensation will be allowed. The State of Maine reserves the right to reject your bid if you are unwilling to accept this condition.

INVOICES: Separate invoices are required for each order number. All invoices must reference Contract Number and Vendor Customer Number, failure to do so could cause lengthy delays of payment of invoices. All invoices should be issued within 30 days of delivery and paid in accordance with the commodity terms and conditions attached to the contract.

PRICE ADJUSTMENTS: Prices quoted shall remain firm for the duration of the contract. Prices may be subject to an increase ONLY based on general industry changes as evidenced by revised printed price lists or notices from the manufacturer and such evidence may be requested by the Division of Purchases before a price change notice will be issued. All contract orders (oral or written) dated prior to the effective date of the increase shall be filled at the old price(s). The State reserves the right to reject any price increase it deems excessive. Price increases may be allowed due to changes in State and/or Federal law(s) with proper documentation.

Any reduction in price may occur anytime during the contract period. The reduced price shall apply on all shipments made on or after the date the reduction price becomes effective.

The State reserves the right to seek additional discounts from the contractor, or to contract separately for single purchase for a particular State project or other immediate use if, in the judgment of the Division of purchases, the quantity required is sufficiently large to enable the State to realize a cost savings over and above the published contract prices, whether or not such a savings actually occurs.

<u>DELIVERY:</u> Deliveries shall be made within seven (7) days of receipt of the order as specified by the contractor in its bid and during the normal receiving hours of the ordering agency. The contractor shall be responsible for the delivery of items in first class condition at the point of delivery, and in accordance with good commercial practice.

TAXES: The State is exempt from the payment of excise taxes. Exemption certificates will be furnished upon request.

REPORT OF PURCHASES: Contractor will be required to furnish the Director of the Division of Purchases with a detailed summary of the total purchases made under this contract. This total may be requested yearly or at any time during the contract period.

<u>CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT:</u> The State of Maine reserves the right to cancel contracts upon a thirty day written notice OR cancel contracts IMMEDIATELY if the contractor does not conform to the terms and conditions of bid/contract.

EXTENSION OF CONTRACT: The Director of the Division of Purchases may, with the consent of the contractor extend the contract beyond the indicated expiration date providing it is in the States best interest.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

If you have a question regarding this RFQ, you must submit your questions thru the Question and Answer link on the Solicitation Details View page. Your answer will appear there as well. It is the vendor's responsibility to log in to view all questions and answers posted there. Questions and Answers obtained any other way will not be valid for this RFQ.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE ORDER

- 1. WARRANTY: Contractor warrants
 - a That all articles and services to be supplied by it under this agreement are fit and sufficient for the purpose intended and
 - b That all articles and services covered by this contract will conform to the specifications, drawing samples, symbols or other description specified by the Division, and
 - c That such articles are merchantable, good quality and free from defects whether patent or latent in material and workmanship, and
 - d That all workmanship, materials and articles to be provided are of the best grade and quality, and
 - e That it has good and clear title to all articles to be supplied by it and the same are free and clear from all liens, encumbrances and security interest.

Neither the final certificate of payment nor any provision herein, nor partial nor entire use of the articles provided shall constitute an acceptance of work not done in accordance with this agreement or relieve the Contractor liability in respect of any warranties or responsibility for faulty material or workmanship. The Contractor shall remedy any defects in the work and pay any damage to other work resulting therefrom, which shall appear within 1 year from the date of final acceptance of the work provided hereunder. The Division of Purchases shall give written notice of observed defects with reasonable promptness.

- 2. TAXES: Contractor agrees that, unless otherwise indicated in the order, the prices herein do not include federal, state or local sales, or use the tax from which an exemption is available for purposes of this order. Contractor agrees to accept and use tax exemption certificates when supplied by the Division as applicable. In case it shall ever be determined that any tax included in the prices herein was not required to be paid by Contractor, Contractor agrees to notify the Division and to make prompt application for the refund thereof, to take all proper steps to procure the same and when received to pay the same to the Division.
- 3. PACKING & SHIPMENT: Deliveries shall be made as specified without charge for boxing, carting or storage, unless otherwise specified. Articles shall be suitably packed to secure lowest transportation cost and to conform with the requirements of common carriers and any applicable specifications. Order numbers and symbols must be plainly marked on all invoices, packages, bills of lading and shipping orders. Bill of lading should accompany each invoice. Count or weight shall be final and conclusive on shipments not accompanied by packing lists.
- 4. DELIVERY: Delivery should be strictly in accordance with delivery schedule. If Contractor's deliveries fail to meet such schedule, The Division, without limiting its other remedies, may direct expedited routing and the difference between the expedited routing and the order routing costs shall be paid by the Contractor. Articles fabricated beyond the Division's releases are at Contractor shall not make material commitments or production arrangements in excess of the amount or in advance of the time necessary to meet delivery schedule, and, unless otherwise specified herein, no deliveries shall be made in advance of the Division's delivery schedule. Neither party shall be liable for excess costs of deliveries or defaults due to the causes beyond its control and without its fault or negligence, provided, however, that when the Contractor has reason to believe that the deliveries will not be made as scheduled, written notice setting forth the cause of the anticipated delay will be given immediately to the Division. If the Contractor's delay or default is caused by the delay or default of a subcontractor, such delay or default shall be excusable only if it arose out of causes beyond the control of both Contractor and without fault of negligence or either of them and the articles or services to be furnished were not obtainable from other sources in sufficient time to permit Contractor to meet the required delivery schedule.
- 5. INSPECTION: All articles and work will be subject to final inspection and approval after delivery, notwithstanding prior payment, it being expressly agreed that payment will not constitute final acceptance. Division of Purchases at its option may either reject any article or work not in conformity with the requirements and terms of this order, or re-work the same at Contractor's expense. The Division may reject the entire shipment where it consists of a quantity of similar articles and sample inspection discloses that ten (10%) percent of the articles inspected are defective, unless Contractor agrees to reimburse the Division for the cost of a complete inspection of the articles included in such shipment. Rejected material may be returned at Contractor's risk and expense at the full invoice price plus applicable incoming transportation charges, if any. No replacement of defective articles of work shall be made unless specified by the Division.
- 6. INVOICE: The original and duplicate invoices covering each and every shipment made against this order showing purchase order number, vendor number and other essential particulars, must be forwarded promptly to the ordering agency concerned by the vendor to whom the order is issued. Delays in receiving invoice and also errors and omissions on statements will be considered just cause for withholding settlement without losing discount privileges. All accounts are to be carried in the name of the agency or institution receiving the goods, and not in the name of the Division of Purchases.
- 7. ALTERATIONS: The Division reserves the right to increase or decrease all or any portion of the work and the articles required to be provided by the bidding documents or this agreements, or to eliminate all or any portion of such work or articles or to change delivery date hereon without validating this agreement. All such alterations shall be in writing. If any such alterations are made, the contract amount or amounts shall be adjusted accordingly. In no event shall Contractor fail or refuse to continue the performance of the work in providing of articles under this agreement because of the inability of the parties to agree on an adjustment or adjustments.
- 8. DEFAULT: The Division may terminate the whole or any part of this agreement in any one of the following circumstances:
 - a. The Contractor fails to make delivery of articles, or to perform services within the time or times specified herein, or
 - b. If Contractor fails to deliver specified materials or services, or
 - c. If Contractor fails to perform any of the provisions of this agreement, or
 - d. If Contractor so fails to make progress as to endanger the performance of this agreement in accordance with its terms, or
 - e. If Contractor is adjudged bankrupt, or if it makes a general assignment for the benefit of its creditors or if a receiver is appointed on account of its insolvency.

In the event that the Division terminates this agreement in whole or in part pursuant to this paragraph, the Division may procure (articles and services similar to those so terminated) upon such terms and in such manner as the Division deems appropriate, and Contractor shall be liable to the Division for any excess cost of such similar articles or services.

- 9. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS: Contractor agrees that, in the performance hereof, it will comply with applicable laws, including, but not limited to statutes, rules, regulations or orders of the United States Government or of any state or political subdivision(s) thereof, and the same shall be deemed incorporated herein by reference. Access by the grantee, the subgrantee, the Federal grantor agency, the Comptroller General of the United States, or any of their duly authorized representatives to any books, documents, papers and records of the contractor which are directly pertinent to that specific contract for the purpose of making audit, examination, excerpts, and transcriptions. Retention of all required records for three years after grantees or subgrantees make final payments and all other pending matters are closed. Compliance with all applicable standards, orders, or requirements issued under section 306 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 1857(h), section 508 of the Clean Water Act, (33 U.S.C. 1368), Executive Order 11738, and Environmental Protection Agency regulations (40 CFR part 15). (Contracts, subcontracts, and subgrants of amounts in excess of \$100,000). Mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency which are contained in the state energy conservation plan issued in compliance with Energy Policy and Conservation Act (Pub. L. 94-163, 89 Stat. 871).
- 10. INTERPRETATION: This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Maine as to interpretation and performance
- 11. DISPUTES: The Division will decide any and all questions which may arise as to the quality and acceptability of articles provided and installation of such articles, and as to the manner of performance and rate of progress under this contract. The Division will decide all questions, which may arise as to the interpretation of the terms of this agreement and the fulfillment of this agreement on the part of the contractor.
- 12. ASSIGNMENT: None of the sums due or to become due nor any of the work to be performed under this order shall be assigned nor shall Contractor subcontract for completed or substantially completed articles called for by this order without the Division's prior written consent. No subcontract or transfer of agreement shall in any case release the Contractor of its obligations and liabilities under this agreement.
- 13. HOLD HARMLESS: The Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend and save harmless the Bureau of General Services, its divisions, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any and all contractors, subcontractors, material men, laborers and other persons, firm or corporation furnishing or supplying work, services, articles, or supplies in connection with the performance of this agreement, and from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any person, firm or corporation who may be injured or damaged by the Contractor in the performance of this agreement.
- 14. SOLICITATION: The Contractor warrants that it has not employed or written any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the contractor to solicit or secure this agreement, and it has not paid, or agreed to pay any company, or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Contractor any fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gifts, or any other consideration, contingent upon, or resulting from the award for making this agreement. For breach or violation or this warranty, the Division shall have the absolute right to annul this agreement or, in its discretion, to deduct from the agreement price or consideration, or otherwise recover the full amount of such fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gifts, or contingent fee.
- 15. WAIVER: The failure of the Division to insist, in any one or more instances, upon the performance of any of the terms, covenants, or conditions of this order or to exercise any right hereunder, shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment of the future performance of any such term, covenant or condition or the future exercise of such right, but the obligation of contractor with respect to such future performance shall continue in full force and effect.
- 16. All manufacturers, importers, suppliers, or distributors of hazardous chemicals doing business in this State must provide a copy of the current material safety data sheet for any hazardous chemical to their direct purchasers of that chemical.

Purpose

The purpose of this Customer Technical Bulletin (CTB) is to inform our customers of the rebranding of the Aptima® Vaginal Swab Specimen Collection Kit (Cat. No. 301162) to the Aptima Multitest Swab Specimen Collection Kit (Cat. No. PRD-03546), which is intended to be utilized to collect patient samples for use with multiple Aptima® assays and with multiple sample types.

Scope

This CTB is effective upon receipt and is intended for site administrators, laboratory supervisors and operators.

The newly available Aptima Multitest Swab Specimen Collection Kit will accommodate the collection of additional sample types and support our continued focus on the expansion of our Aptima assay menu for use on Hologic systems.

What is Affected

The new Aptima Multitest Swab Specimen Collection Kit is a relabeled Aptima Vaginal Swab Collection Kit (Cat. No. 301162) and will replace the Aptima Vaginal Swab Collection Kit. There will be a temporary transition period where both collection kits will be available. On a future date to be determined, Hologic will cease production of the Aptima® Vaginal Swab and only the Aptima® Multitest Swab Specimen Collection Kit (Cat. No. PRD-03546) will be available.

The shift in nomenclature from "vaginal" to "multitest" is solely a Hologic relabeling initiative to accommodate additional specimen types. There have been no other changes to the product. The Aptima Multitest Swab Specimen Collection Kit has been validated by Hologic for use with the following assays: Aptima Combo 2[®] assay, Aptima[®] Chlamydia trachomatis assay, Aptima Neisseria gonorrhoeae assay, Aptima Trichomonas vaginalis assay and Aptima[®] HSV 1 & 2 assay.
