Working Definition: Blue Economy

DEFINITION USED IN LEGISLATION (based on World Bank definition):

As used in this resolve, "blue economy" means business sectors that rely on the sustainable use of ocean resources for economic health, improved livelihoods, jobs or ecosystem health.

PROPOSED ADDITION:

In Maine, the Blue Economy consists of economic activity that honors our state's history of sustainably using ocean and coastal resources to nourish communities, foster innovation, and provide a model for generation of wealth from the ocean to create a more prosperous future.
