#### **Grow Local Talent Spreadsheet Overview**

- 10 v ERC Tab:
  - DECD took a first stab at matching the ERC recommendations (column C) to the action items within the 10-year plan (column B)
  - Refer to the Maine Economic Development Strategy report for more detail on each action item listed in column B
  - Refer to the Economic Recovery Committee report for more detail on each recommendation listed in column C
  - This is a starting place to work from, not set in stone. The ERC recommendations might align better with a different 10-year plan action item, and others that are relevant might not be included in this spreadsheet.

• Matrix Tab:

- For each ERC recommendation, this matrix indicates whether:
  - it adds little detail, significant detail, or a unique topic/angle to the 10-Year Plan action item
  - it requires Governor's/State Agency's Action, Appropriation/Statutory Change, or Public-Private Partnership

• Priorities Tab

- We can use this template to outline the prioritization of our projects
- Questions to consider for each project/priority:

- Who will lead the implementation an individual, a subset of the work group, or the group as a whole? Are there pieces that should be implemented fully outside the work group structure?
- What is the projected timeframe the project will take to accomplish?
- What are the next steps for implementation of the project?
- What is the deadline to accomplish these next steps?
- Are there any outstanding questions we need answered before we can start on implementation?

# **Questions/Discussion**

- Need a better understanding of each topic within the 10-year plan and ERC report
  - What is the goal of each action item?
  - What work is already being done in this area? What are the current strengths and limitations of these efforts? Where are there gaps?
- For instance, looking at the Maine's Career Exploration topic:
  - Could define a career exploration goal for each age group
  - Align the revised Maine Learning Standards (K-12) with this work
  - Organizations/programs already working in this area
    - JMG
    - Junior Achievement
    - C3
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Could catalogue the existing programs and identify any gaps and areas for enhancement  $\;$ 
    - How robust are existing programs? Is there evidence of their impact?
    - Need to map out what currently exists and where there are barriers, successes, limitations (in terms of geography, age, etc.)
- How do we prioritize long-term goals versus urgent needs?
  - The ERC report identifies more urgent needs in wake of the COVID-19 economic crisis, and provides recommendations for addressing these issues and bridging us back to the 10-year plan
  - Some of the ERC recommendations align with action items listed in the 10-year plan
  - The ERC recommendations might be a good starting place for now, but don't want to lose sight of the long-term goals
  - Many of these projects will require resources to implement. Would be good to identify those ones early on.
