FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (C.M.R.) ch. 115, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) finds the following facts:

I. Registration

MRH Corp. d/b/a Northern Light Mayo Hospital (Mayo) has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-186-71-F-R from Hospital Administrative District No. 4 to MRH Corp. d/b/a Northern Light Mayo Hospital through a letter to the Department dated 3/1/2020. Air Emission License A-186-71-F-R was issued to Hospital Administrative District No. 4 on 8/25/14. The license was subsequently amended on 4/4/2017 (A-186-71-G-A) and 11/13/2017 (A-186-71-H-M) respectively. The facility is a hospital.

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, Mayo submitted copies of property deeds transferring ownership of the facility to MRH Corp. d/b/a Northern Light Mayo Hospital. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Technical Capacity and Intent

Mayo's acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees who currently operate the equipment, facilities, and conduct other activities. The facility's regulatory history with the Department demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that Mayo has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

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C. Full Name and Address

The full name and address of the new owner is:

D. Certification

Mayo certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.

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Based on the above, the Department concludes that the applicant for the air emission license transfer has the capacity to satisfy all applicable statutory criteria and hereby APPROVES the transfer of Air Emission License A-186-71-F-R, Amendment A-186-71-G-A and Amendment A-186-71-H-M from Hospital Administrative District No. 4 to MRH Corp. d/b/a Northern Light Mayo Hospital, subject to all conditions attached to them.

Severability. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Transfer or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Transfer shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
