FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the air emission license amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 344 and § 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

Southport Boats, LLC was issued Air Emission License A-1122-71-A-N on April 18, 2017, for the operation of emission sources associated with their boat manufacturing facility. The license was subsequently transferred to Southport Yachts, LLC (Southport) on September 26, 2017 (A-1122-71-B-T). Southport has requested a minor revision to their license in order to change the address of their facility due to a recent change in location.

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

II. MINOR REVISION DESCRIPTION

A. Address Change

When Air Emission License A-1122-71-A-N (April 18, 2017) was issued, Southport's operations were located at 681 Riverside Drive in Augusta, Maine, collocated with CPK Manufacturing, LLC. Recently, Southport outgrew this space and moved their operations and licensed emission equipment to a new facility located in Gardiner, Maine.

B. Annual Emissions

The facility's licensed annual emissions are not changing with this amendment and shall remain as currently licensed.

ORDER

Based on the above Findings and subject to conditions listed below, the Department concludes that the emissions from this source:

- will receive Best Practical Treatment,
- will not violate applicable emission standards, and
- will not violate applicable ambient air quality standards in conjunction with emissions from other sources.

The Department hereby grants Air Emission License Amendment A-1122-71-C-M subject to the conditions found in Air Emission License A-1122-71-A-N.

<u>Severability</u>. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Amendment or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Amendment shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.

There are no amended or additional license conditions as a result of this license amendment.
