Part 70 Air Emission License  
Amendment #3**

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

After review of the Part 70 License amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 344 and § 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

**I. REGISTRATION**

**A. Introduction**

Waste Management Disposal Services of Maine, Inc. (WMDSM) d/b/a Crossroads Landfill is a municipal solid waste landfill.

WMDSM has requested an administrative revision to correct a typographical error regarding Generator #1.

**B. Emission Equipment**

The following emission units are addressed by this Part 70 License:

**Emergency Generators**

### **C. Revision Description**

Generator #1 is an emergency back-up generator. It was included in WMDSM's Part 70 license beginning with A-816-70-C-R/A (issued 7/18/2014). Prior to that time, it was considered an insignificant activity.

The licensed nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) emission limit for Generator #1 is incorrectly listed as 3.97 lb/hr. However, the original application indicated the maximum potential emissions of NO<sub>x</sub> to be 4.00 lb/hr. WMDSM has requested that this error be corrected to prevent the appearance of non-compliance.

The Department agrees and finds that a NO<sub>x</sub> emission limit of 4.00 lb/hr represents Best Practical Treatment (BPT) for Generator #1.

### **D. Application Classification**

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

A Part 70 Administrative Revision is for license changes that correct typographical errors; change the name, address, or phone number of any person or facility identified in the Part 70 license or a similar administrative change at the Part 70 source; or result in more frequent monitoring, reporting, recordkeeping or testing requirements.

The requested revision to correct the NO<sub>x</sub> emission limit for Generator #1 meets the definition of a Part 70 Administrative Revision and has been processed under *Part 70 Air Emission License Regulations*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 140.

### **E. Facility Annual Emissions**

This license amendment will not change the facility's licensed annual emissions.

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**ORDER**

Based on the above Findings and subject to conditions listed below, the Department concludes that emissions from this source:

- will receive Best Practical Treatment;
- will not violate applicable emissions standards; and
- will not violate applicable ambient air quality standards in conjunction with emissions from other sources.

The Department hereby grants the Part 70 License Amendment A-816-70-K-A pursuant to 06-096 C.M.R. 140 and the preconstruction permitting requirements of *Major and Minor Source Air Emission License Regulations*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 115 and subject to the conditions found in Air Emission License A-816-70-H-R, in amendments A-816-70-I-A and A-816-70-J-A, and the following conditions.

Federally enforceable conditions in this Part 70 license must be changed pursuant to the applicable requirements in 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 115 for making such changes and pursuant to the applicable requirements in 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 140.

For each specific condition which is state enforceable only, state-only enforceability is designated with the following statement: **Enforceable by State-only.**

Severability. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Amendment or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Amendment shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.

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**SPECIFIC CONDITIONS**

The following shall replace Condition (16)(A) of Air Emission License A-816-70-H-R:

**(16) Generators #1 and #2**

- A. Emissions shall not exceed the following limits:
