Hi, I submitted written testimony for the February 2024 hearing about whether to extend the contract for Juniper Ridge Landfill, and I had asked that it not pass.

There are many reasons why I say no, but in my letter, I focused on Casella's mission statement: "We have grown over the past 40+ years by putting the needs of our customers first and helping them to capture value from waste through innovative Resource Solutions."
