The Bureau of Hazardous Materials and Solid Waste Control has reviewed the information you have submitted in accordance with Special Condition #2 of Department Order #S-4892-WD-G-A, dated October 14, 1993, and issued pursuant to Title 38 M.R.S.A. Section 1301, et seq.

Condition #2 reads as follows:

Within thirty (30) days of completion of construction of the base drainage system in Phase II-South, the applicant shall submit to the Department as-built drawings noting the locations of the 6-inch drainage pipes.

In response to this condition you have submitted an as-built drawing, dated February 7, 1994, which depicts the surveyed locations of the 6-inch drainage pipes within the Phase II-South portion of the landfill.

As the result of its review, the department has found that this information does satisfactorily address the requirement of Condition #2.
