Dear Mr. Gallant:

The Bureau of Hazardous Materials and Solid Waste Control has reviewed the information you have submitted in accordance with Special Condition #2 of Department Order #S-4892-WD-N-M, dated January 27, 1994, and issued pursuant to Title 38 M.R.S.A. Section 1301 et seq., and 06-096 CMR Chapter 400 et seq., Solid Waste Management Rules.

Condition #2 reads as follows: Should additional sources of ash be required in order to maintain the bulking ratio necessary for stability, other than those previously identified above, the results of analytical work shall be submitted to the Department for review and approval.

In response to this condition you have submitted:

1. A copy of a letter from Doug Timberlake of Forster, Inc. in Wilton, ME to Dave Ellis of Browning-Ferris Industries in Brewer, ME dated March 30, 1994. The letter states what the typical fuel usage at Forster, Inc.'s Wilton Facility is and what types of wastes are burned in the boiler at this facility;
2. An October 11, 1993, report from Maine Environmental Laboratory of Yarmouth, ME showing results of parameter testing on wood ash samples from Forster Manufacturing STR, submitted by Resource Conservation Services of Bangor, ME;
3. A November 12, 1993, report from Maine Environmental Laboratory of Yarmouth showing the results of TCLP testing on biomass ash samples from Forster Manufacturing Co., submitted by Browning-Ferris Industries; and
4. A November 15, 1993, six page report from Analytics Environmental Laboratory, Inc. of Portsmouth, NH showing the results of TCLP: Volatiles, Semi-Volatiles, Pesticides and Herbicides testing on ash from Forster Manufacturing Co., submitted by Browning-Ferris Industries.


