The landfill serves a critical role in the management of all waste materials from our City, especially the disposal of municipal solid waste (MSW). Our City sees the continued operation of the Crossroads facility as critical to keeping the current costs paid for disposal of MSW and recycling materials stable. Without the Crossroads facility, we would be forced to ship our waste significant distances because there are no other local disposal options.
