Dear Ms. Butler:

On Tuesday, September 18, 2018, the Wilton Board of Selectpersons voted unanimously to support Waste Management Disposal Services of Maine's continued operation of its Crossroads facility in Norridgewock. In particular, they voted to support the recently proposed expansion application of the Crossroads facility.

The Crossroads facility serves a critical role in the management of waste materials for Wilton, specifically, the disposal of municipal solid waste. The Wilton Selectpersons see the continued operation of the Crossroads facility as critical to keeping the current costs paid for disposal and recycling services stable. Without the Crossroads facility, we would be forced to ship our waste significant distances because there are no other local disposal options. This would force us to spend more taxpayer dollars for the same service that is currently available locally. The public benefit is clearly exhibited by the ongoing availability the Crossroad facility has provided to our community and many others in Maine. Locally available waste disposal services are an important component to the overall infrastructure of our state and region and the continued operation of the Crossroads facility is fully supported by the Town of Wilton.

The Town of Wilton, ME supports WMDSM's expansion of its Crossroads Facility and we urge the DEP to do the same.
