I spent my childhood living in Orono, playing in and along that section of the Penobscot. I was taught at Asa Adams Elementary School about the importance of the River, both to nature and to the surrounding Native American tribes who depend on it. The past two decades have seen an effort to clean up the River (I myself remember that deep orange color the water always has when I was a child), but there is still a LONG way to go to undo decades of damage.
