
Dear Marybeth:

The Department's Fourth Procedural Order sets the deadline for final briefs in this matter for June 30, 2017, at 5 pm. On behalf of the Intervenor, I request a two-week extension of this deadline for the parties' submissions.

In support of this request, a combination of professional and personal conflicts between now and June 30<sup>th</sup> will make it very difficult to complete the brief within this time period, including responding to a pending motion to strike, answer and counterclaims, and submission of a final brief in two previously scheduled Superior Court proceedings.
