By this memorandum, and pursuant to *Organization and Powers*, 38 M.R.S. § 341-A(3)(C) and the Department's *Rules Governing the Conduct of Licensing Hearings*, 06-096 CMR 3(4)(1)(b) (Chapter 3), I hereby delegate authority to you to serve as presiding officer with respect to a public hearing to consider the applications by the Maine Turnpike Authority for a *Natural Resources Protection Act* permit pursuant to 38 M.R.S. §480-A et seq., DEP #L-27241-TG-A-N, and for a Site Location of Development Act General Permit pursuant to 38 M.R.S. §486-B et seq., DEP #L-27275-TP-A-N, York, York County. The purpose of this delegation is to authorize you to conduct and preside over an evidentiary hearing to develop a factual record for decision-making in this matter. This delegation is limited in its scope to the authority necessary to administer governing procedural statutes and regulations in the development of the administrative record, and does not include the ultimate decision-making authority on the merits of the application, which I expressly retain as Commissioner. The terms of this delegation are not intended to and shall not be interpreted as limiting communication between and among me as Commissioner, you in your capacity as presiding officer, and any other agency staff person, before, during, or after the hearing, regarding any substantive or procedural issue raised by the application.
