Know all men by these Presents,

That I, Albert W. Grant of West Roxbury, Suffolk County,
Commonwealth of Massachusetts

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations

paid by The Central Securities Corporation of Augusta, Kennebec
County, Maine

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant,
bargain, sell and convey, unto the said Central Securities Corporation

and my successors Heirs and Assigns forever,

Two certain lots or parcels of land in the town of Leeds, Androscoggin
County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

First Parcel: A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width
extending from my northerly to my southerly line and bounded northerly
by land now or formerly of Clifton R. Wilson, easterly by a line
parallel with and sixty-two and one-half (62 1/2) feet easterly of
the survey line now staked out across my lot, the Wilson lot and the
Morris lot; southerly by land now or formerly of Bertell Morris;
westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and
one-half (337 1/2) feet westerly of the above described survey line.
Containing about five (5) acres.

Reserving to the grantor his heirs or assigns an easement or right of
way across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural
purposes, not to exceed twenty feet in width and to be
located by the grantees its successors and assigns, in some location
convenient for the said grantor, his heirs or assigns, and which will
not however interfere with the use of the said above described parcel
in connection with the transmission of electric energy.

Second Parcel: A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width
extending from my northerly to my southerly line and bounded,
northerly by land now or formerly of Bertell Morris et al; easterly
by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half (62 1/2) feet
easterly of the survey line now staked out across my lot, the Phillips
lot and the Townsend lot; southerly by land now or formerly of B.
Emery Townsend and land now or formerly of Alton L. Thomas; westerly
by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and one-half
(337 1/2) feet westerly of the above described survey line, by land
now or formerly of Alton L. Thomas and by land now or formerly of
Bertell Morris at highway; Containing about twenty-one (21) acres.

Excepting from the above any portion of the Phillips lot, the Morris
lot which may be included within the above described boundaries.

My title to both of the above parcels was derived as sole heir of
Charles T. Grant.

Excepting from the second parcel any rights of the public in and to the
of the highway across this lot.

Reserving to the grantor his heirs or assigns an easement or right of way across the second described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural purposes, not to exceed twenty feet in width and to be located by the grantee its successors and assigns, in some location convenient for the said grantor, his heirs or assigns, and which will not however interfere with the use of the said above described parcel in connection with the transmission of electric energy.
